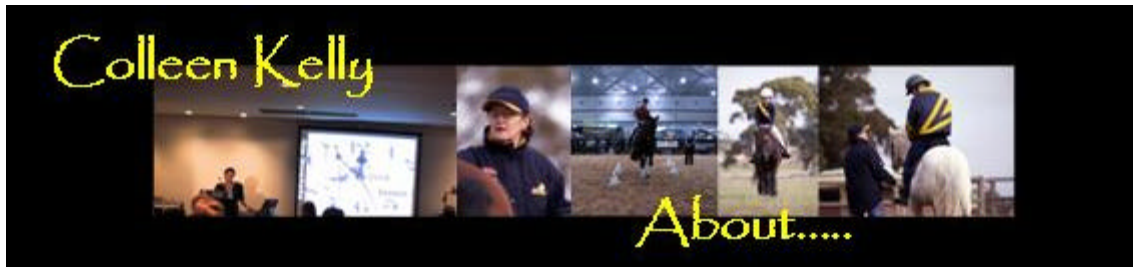

Colleen is well-known for receiving a remarkable 100% in her Official Dressage Judge's Exam, however it's her "Irish Sense of Humor" and fun presentations that keep audiences around the world laughing, and has seen her awarded with 3 separate awards from Riding for Disabled.
