Recently Gina has served as Vice President of Dressage as well as President for the Georgia Dressage & Combined Training Association ([GDCTA](#)), a USDF GMO and has been busy planning educational opportunities for its members. Gina organized a 2 day educational symposium held in 1995 and 1996 led by Gerhard Politz, who returned in 1997 for another symposium, per membership request.
