Dr. John Lew was born in Hong Kong but grew up in Melbourne, Australia. He is a graduate from the University of Tasmania with an undergraduate degree in Agricultural Science.

Dr. Lew earned his PhD in equine nutrition from the University of Kentucky in 1989, and prior to that he served as a research fellow at UK, centering his studies on animal science and pharmacology. He also managed the University of Kentucky horse farm for four years. While a student at UK, he also worked at many of the horse sales as a groom and handler of yearlings, weanlings and broodmares.

Since 1989 Dr. Lew has been Director of Research and Technical Service for McCauley Bros. Inc. In his daily duties, Dr. Lew is responsible for the formulation of feed products, quality control, manufacturing process, ingredient specifications and nutritional consultation around the world.
